REGULATIONS

## 1. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for Club Championship points, an individual must be a fully paid up member of the Aberdare Motor Club (AMC)

All Motorsport events attended by a club member will qualify for points

#### 4. CHAMPIONSHIP TERM

The Championships will run annually from 1st January to 31st December.

Due to club reestablishment in 2024, any events attended prior to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2024 can still be put forward for full points.

## 5. CLAIMING POINTS

For all events, members must submit their results via the electronic form that can be found on the Aberdare Motor Club website within 14 days of the event

The Championship Coordinator reserves the right to request proof of results from members. Wherever possible the Championship Coordinator will aim to provide interim results updates periodically during the championship term. Interim results shall remain provisional at all times. Final results shall be published no later than the 13<sup>th</sup> January 2025.



## 6. SCORING

Points scoring will be as follows:
